STUDENT'S PERSPECTIVES OF SCHOOLOGY APPLICATION IN IMPROVING STUDENT'S LISTENING SKILLS AT UNIKA St. PAULUS RUTENG

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ABSTRACT

E-learning is a type of teaching and learning that allows the delivery of teaching materials to students using the internet, intranet, or other computer network media. Schoology is one of the E-learning platforms that can help teachers to manage classroom. This research used qualitative research and 13 students of the second level of English Study Program, of Indonesian Catholic University of Santu Paulus Ruteng were interviewed. The findings of this study revealed that the students viewed Schoology application is of benefit to improve their listening skills. However, there are still shortcomings in using the schoology application, where students sometimes experience problems with the network so that the audio contained in the application is difficult to access.

INTRODUCTION

The growth of technology, especially information and communication technologies or ICT, nowadays has a big impact on human life. One of the aspects which is affected by the growth of ICT is education. Currently, students can learn not only anywhere but at the time at any with the existing Electronic learning (E-Learning) system facilities. E-learning is now increasingly recognized as a way to solve educational problems, especially during pandemic covid-19. E-learning is a type of teaching and learning that allows the delivery of teaching materials to students using the internet, intranet, or other computer network media (Wahono, 2008:11;

Darong, 2022). Meanwhile, Dabbagh and Ritland (2005:15) and Darong (2020) stated E-learning which defines online learning as an open and distributed learning environment with pedagogic tools, internet, network-based technologies, to facilitate learning and build knowledge through action and interaction.

Some studies give the advantage of E-learning as its ability to focus on the needs of individual learners. Marc (2000) in his book review on E-learning strategies for delivering knowledge in the digital age noted that one of the advantages of e-learning in education is its focus on the needs of individual learners as an important factor in the

process of education rather than on the instructors', or educational institutions' needs. Some of the advantages that the adoption of E-learning in education, includes: The first, it is flexible when issues of time and place are taken into consideration. Every student has the luxury of choosing the place and time that suits him/her. Smedley (2010), stated that the adoption of E-learning provides the institutions as well as their students or learners the much flexibility of time and place of delivery or receipt of according to learning information. Second, E-learning enhances efficacy of knowledge and qualifications via ease of access to a huge amount of information. Third, It is able to provide opportunities for relations between learners by the use of discussion forums. Through this, E-learning helps eliminate barriers that have potential of hindering participation including the fear of talking to other learners. E-learning motivates students to interact with others, as well as exchange and respect different points of view. E-learning eases communication and also improves the relationships that sustain learning. Wagner et al (2008) & Darong & Niman (2021) stated that E-Learning makes available prospects for interactivity between students and teachers during content delivery.

There are many types of E-learning used, one of which is Schoology. Schoology is a learning management system (LMS) or course management system (CMS), cloud-based platforms provide the tools needed to manage an online class (Mchichi,2012). This platform facilitates collaboration

among a class, a group, or a school. (Byrd 2013) listed the advantages of Schoology including the easiness of use, the security for student safety, and the efficient tools and resources for teachers. Schoology-based E-learning has been used at the Indonesian Catholic University of St. Paul Ruteng, especially in the English language study program.

In learning a language, listening as a basic language skill is the key for effective foundation all communication. This is the ability to accurately receive and deal with messages in communication process that helps language learners to acquire word stress, pronunciation, vocabulary and understand the message. Without the ability to listen effectively, messages are easily misunderstood. Result no communication can be achieved. Therefore, listening is more complex than just hearing. It is a process consisting of four stages: feeling and paying attention, understanding and paying attention, remembering, responding. Rost (2002) states that listening is mental the process of constructing meaning from spoken put in very important to listen in language class, English learners have to work difficult to improve their listening skills. They must practice listening to spoken language through Radio, TV and Video as listening enhancementseasy job for student or teacher English. In addition, Harmer (2001) revealed that listening is a receptive skill by which people acquiremain idea according to what they hear. Besides that, Helgsen is quoted by Moncada Gonzales (2003)sayinglistening helps learners become

flexible listeners, toknow how to listen to get a general ideaor specific information needed to understandvideos. Similarly, Richard & Rubin (cited by VanDuzer, 1997) argues that although listening is Passive skills are very active processes pick and choose information from auditory and visual cues.

There some are previous research related to this study. The first, research from Pahamzah, (2021) was conducted with the title "The Impact of OnStudents' Schoology Reading Comprehension And Writing Skill For Senior High School". The objective of this research was to find out the process, the student's response, and the student's improvement in reading comprehension and writing skills after learning narrative text by using Schoology Elearning Web at tenth grade of Senior High School. This research used classroom action research design. The researcher observed and gave treatment improve students' reading comprehension and writing skills. Furthermore, the researcher observation sheets and documentation to collect qualitative data. Besides the researcher also used tests which consisted of pre-test and Post-test for collecting quantitative data. As the result, the process of teaching narrative text by using the Schoology E-learning web was more effective, interesting, and enjoyable for the students. The students responded and did the tasks given immediately. Consequently, influenced their score achievement both in reading comprehension and in writing skills.

The second research was done by Masyhudianti, & Suparno (2018) was

"The conducted with the title effectiveness of Schoology to teach writing viewed from students' creativity. The research was conducted at even semester of tenth-grade students of a Secondary School in Central Java, Indonesia in the academic year of 2017/2018. The data of this research were obtained from a writing test to find out students' writing scores. As a result, the research findings reveal that: (1) Schoology is more effective than Picture Series to teach writing; (2) High creativity students have better writing skills than low creativity students; and (3) There is an interaction between teaching media and students' creativity in teaching writing.

Based on theprevious research studies, the researchers found the similarity and difference of these research with the current research. They have similarities in part which is using Schoology, but this research differ in terms of level and subject. In this research the writers focused on listening skills on university level. Besides, in this research, the writer focusedtheir studies on "students Perception". Then this study is beneficial for teacher and students to engage themselves in listening skill

METHOD

This research design is classified as qualitative research. This qualitative research involves collecting and analyzing data to understand the concepts, and perspectives. Bogdan & Biklen (1992: 21) stated that qualitative research is a research step that produces descriptive data in the form of writing or speech, as well as the behavior

of the people being observed. This study aims to gain a general understanding of social reality from the participant's point of view. Meanwhile, the researchers collect data through interviews. Esterberg in Sugiyono (2015: 72) stated that interview is a meeting conducted by two people to exchange information or an idea by means of question and

answer, so that it can be reduced to a conclusion or meaning in a particular topic. In this research, 13 students of the second level of English Study Program, of Indonesian Catholic University of Santu Paulus Ruteng were interviewed.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION

Based on the table above, the researcher have received answers from 13 students. In this case, the researchers gave 6 questions related to the application of schoology in listening learning, where in the first question the researcher asked about the period of use of the schoology and application, all participants answered that the schoology application was used for 1 semester. In the second question, the researcher asked questions about their speaking ability before using the schoology application, and all participants answered on average that their listening skills were still lacking. In the third question, the

researcher asked how their abilities were after using the schoology application, and all participants answered on average that their listening skills had improved. In the fourth question, the researcher asked about the advantages of the schoology application, and all participants answered on average that the application was easy to access, the audio played was very clear, the teacher could provide feedback after the students listened to the audio. In the fifth question, the researcher asked about the shortcomings of the schoology application and on average they answered that there were problems with the network, so that sometimes the audio was difficult to download. In addition, students are not free to access audio because of the timing, so that sometimes students cannot access audio when the time is over. While in the last question, the researcher asked about the suggestions given by students to improve the quality of the application, where the participants suggested that the audio timing could be longer so that it could be accessed at any time, so that students could continue to improve their listening skills.

After the researchers analyzing the answers from all participants, the researchers concluded that the use of the schoology application in listening learning had a positive impact on their listening skills because after using the schoology application, all participants experienced an increase in their listening skills. Even so, there are still shortcomings in using the schoology application, where students sometimes experience problems with the network so that the audio contained in the application is difficult to access. This is because the schoology application cannot be accessed offline. In addition, the timing of the schoology application is very limited so that the audio cannot be accessed at any time. But, indeed basically online learning every application has advantages and disadvantages, especially the network, so that the shortcomings of the schoology application that are felt by students are still considered reasonable, the point is that their listening skills can still improve. Seeing this condition, the teacher is expected to be able to evaluate the shortcomings of the schoology

application, especially in the time setting provided.

The results of the research obtained by the researchers are the same as the results of previous studies, where the application of schoology has a very positive impact on students' English skills, especially on listening, reading and writing skills. This is because in previous research conducted by Pahamzah (2021) on the impact of using the schoology application on and writing skills, reading the researchers found that schoology was very effective, interesting, and enjoyable. We can see this from the result of the test which has been given to students. The students' mean score gained in pretest on reading was 62.8 and writing skill was 55.8. In post-test 1, the mean of reading comprehension improved into 77.2 and 71.5 on writing skill. The results of post-test 2 indicated the improvement of students' reading comprehension and writing skill. The mean score of students' reading comprehension improved into 83.3 and 76.9 on writing skill Based on the finding of this research, it can be concluded that the use of Schoology elearning web during online learning period was successful to improve students; reading comprehension and writing skill particularly in narrative text at tenth grade of Senior High School.

While another research conducted by Masyhudianti & Suparno (2018) on the influence of schoology application for teaching writing, the researcher found that the schoology application was more effective than picture series, high creativity students have better writing skill than low

creativity students, and there is an interaction betweem teaching media and students creativity in teaching. We can see from the test whuch has given to students. The results show that the mean scores of HS (high creativity students taught by using Schoology) 1 is 85, HP (high creativity students taught by using Picture Series) 2 is 73.62, LS (low creativity students taught by using Schoology)1 is 72.31, and LP (low creativity students taught by using Picture Series) 2 is 72.69.

CONCLUSION

Based on the findings the researchers concluded that the use of schoology applications in listening learning had a positive impact on their listening skills. Even so, there are still shortcomings in using the schoology application, where students sometimes experience problems with the network so that the audio contained in the application is difficult to access. This is because the schoology application cannot be accessed offline. In addition, the timing of the schoology application is very limited so that the audio cannot be accessed at any time. The researchers suggests that further researchers can conduct research on other aspects of learning English, related to the use of schoology applications.

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
